## Welcome

to the *Day & Night Devotional* for the book of Psalms, from the Old Testament of the Bible. This tool will guide you each <u>day</u> and <u>night</u> to read a given Scripture from Psalms. Then in a prayer to God, either out loud, in your heart, or in a journal, you'll answer some reflection questions. Use this time to turn off your phone and other distractions and enjoy God's presence.

Check out what Psalm 1:1-3 (NLT) says:

Oh, the joys of those who do not follow the advice of the wicked, or stand around with sinners, or join in with mockers. But they delight in the law of the LORD, meditating on it day and night. They are like trees planted along the riverbank, bearing fruit each season. Their leaves never wither, and they prosper in all they do.

If you are reading this, then it's evident that you want to be like that tree planted along the riverbank — never withering and prospering in all you do. So, consider yourself challenged to spend just a few minutes in God's Word both day and night for the next 30 days. See what God will do in you and through you as you draw close to Him.

Scripture: Psalm 1:1–3  Day: How has following the advice of the wicked led you down a path that leads to destruction?
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Night: How would your life look different if you were like the tree mentioned in this Psalm?
Scripture: Psalm 3:1–4  Day: In a very practical way, how do you need God to be your shield today? Cry out to Him because He hears you!
Night: How could preaching truth to yourself from God's Word turn haters' mocking into fuel for your faith?
Scripture: Psalm 5:7–8  Day: Ask God now to show you which path to follow today. Ask for wisdom for your day.

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
