



How to be a Disciple is a series that pulls straight from Mark 8:22-10:52, where Jesus teaches His disciples what it means to be a disciple while they are traveling. This section of Mark begins with Jesus healing a blind man and ends with Jesus healing a blind man. This section of Scripture has many great lessons, but those lessons become much deeper and more meaningful when you bring in the context of all that happens in Mark 8:22-10:52.

Message Break Down

Week 1: *How to be a Disciple: How to See Clearly*

Main Scripture(s): Mark 8:22-38

- Looking at what it means to be a disciple
- Looking at Jesus using spit to heal a blind man
- Looking at Jesus' question to his disciples: "Who do you say I am?"

Week 2: *How to be a Disciple: How to Believe*

Main Scripture(s): Mark 9:1-8; 14-29

- Looking at the Transfiguration
- Looking at the belief of a father whose son needed healed

Week 3: *How to be a Disciple: How to Treat Others*

Main Scripture(s): Mark 9:33-50; 10:13-16; 35-44

- Looking at the disciples wanting to be great
- Looking at how Jesus treats children and the outcast

Week 4: *How to be a Disciple: How to Follow*

Main Scripture(s): Mark 10:17-29; 46-52

- Looking at Jesus' conversation with a rich man
- Looking at Jesus' healing of blind Bartimaeus
