



## **Day 1: Remember the Moment**

Key Verse: Psalm 77:11

It's easy to move on quickly and forget what God did. But remembering helps us keep our faith strong and reminds us that God is always at work. That moment you had this summer wasn't random; it was God reaching out to you personally. Recalling it now can strengthen you when life gets tough.

### ***Reflection Questions:***

- What moment from the summer still gives you chills?
- Why do you think God showed up for you in that way?
- How can you remember that moment this year?

## **Day 2: Faith That Lasts**

Key Verse: Colossians 2:6-7

Summer events are often the spark, but God wants your faith to keep growing long after the campfire dies out. Being rooted means choosing to stay close to Him day by day, even when emotions fade. That's how real, lasting faith is built. It's not about hype; it's about habits.

### ***Reflection Questions:***

- What do you think it means to be 'rooted' in Jesus?
- What small habit could help you grow stronger roots?

### **Day 3: Real Faith Over Hype**

Key Verse: James 1:22

Feeling close to God in a big moment is powerful, but what matters is how you live it out now. God's Word is meant to shape how we think, speak, and act. Faith becomes real when it moves from inspiration to obedience. Don't just be moved; be changed.

#### ***Reflection Questions:***

- Are there parts of your life where you're 'listening but not doing'?
- What's one thing you know God wants you to act on?

### **Day 4: When Life Feels Flat**

Key Verse: Galatians 6:9

After summer highs, regular life can feel spiritually dull. But God often does His deepest work in the quiet, unseen places. Keep going; He's still growing you, even when you don't feel it. Don't give up when it's hard; that's when faith gets real.

#### ***Reflection Questions:***

- What's been harder since getting home?
- What keeps you going when the excitement fades?

### **Day 5: God is Still with You**

Key Verse: Joshua 1:9

It can feel like God was with you at camp, but now you're on your own. That's not true. God promises to be with you wherever you go; at school, practice, home, everywhere. You're not walking alone, even on hard days.
