Objective:

Kids will learn why they need to follow God's lead.

Key Passage:

I Kings 17:7-24, Elijah and the Widow

Introduction:

How many of you guys like to build things? How many fans of LEGO bricks or Mega Blocks do we have here this morning?

If you're a building block fan, you're in luck, because for the next four weeks, we're going to be talking all about your favorite thing!

LEGO bricks are one of the most popular toys in the world. LEGO, Mega Blocks, and other building blocks are incredibly flexible toys. You can use them to build just about anything you can imagine. For example, how many of you have ever received a Star Wars LEGO kit? Or maybe a Super Heroes kit? Those kits come with specific parts made for a specific purpose. Kids and adults buy those sets because they want to make something specific, like a Millennium Falcon or a Batmobile. You can play around with the kits and build just about anything you can dream up, but if you want to build that Millennium Falcon or that Batmobile, the best way to do it is to follow directions.
