

How to Use This Resource

Thank you for purchasing GREATER THAN > Porn. We hope you find this resource to be a valuable tool in your work with students. Below you will find a few suggestions on how to use this resource, as well as what's included with your download.

Suggestions

This is a conversation-based series. Project Six19 has learned that some of the best education on sex comes not from lecturing students, but from including them in the dialogue. That is your job with this material!

The way we've seen this work best is by having small groups participate during the talk. Rather than having them meet before or after, have them answer questions during the talk and then share their responses with the group. This will provide some great dialogue and opportunities to go further than the material written.

This series becomes more of a success the less you talk and the more students share. And sometimes, where you hoped to finish might look a little different because of what was shared. See this as a win! This means you've included student in the talk! Use the scripts/outlines as a guide but don't be so stuck on them that you don't allow room for the Holy Spirit to do an amazing work that provides conversations you might not have thought of prior to the start of the talk.

As you let conversations form, you will get to hear exactly what your students are thinking about sex and pornography. That is a wonderful gift and incredible opportunity to minister and each to every one of your students.

Included in the Download:

Parents' Letter and Outlines

Utilize the letter to share with parents the goal of the GREATER THAN > Porn series for your students. Every week will also have an outline you can send that will help parents continue the conversation in the home. The second week also includes a handout, 'Tech Wise Home.' It's best to send these out before the series starts.

Leader Outlines

Prepping leaders every week will be important. These outlines are meant to provide cultural analysis and insight into some of that is shared in the talk each week. This will help with the questions asked throughout the series. It's best to send these out ahead of time.

Scripts and Outlines

Each week will have a full script and then a shorter outline the speaker can use to share the GREATER THAN > Porn series.

Slides

These will go hand in hand with the scripts and outlines.

Small Group Handouts

This handout can be given to your leaders so they have a hard copy of the questions. It's best to send this out ahead of time so leaders have time to reflect on some of the questions prior.

14 Day Instagram Devotional

What's The Big Deal? (*with porn*) Teaching Script

Series Goal

To understand that Jesus is GREATER THAN any revelation the world might make about pornography. His plan for sex is best, safest, and healthiest.

Understanding For Talk

Pornography is reshaping the way we think about sex, interact with others, and enter and maintain relationships.

Scripture To Have Ready

Matthew 5:27-30 Genesis 2:24 Genesis 4:1 Romans 8:1

Activities

- Trivia questions throughout the talk.
- Small group conversations.

Takeaways

- We have access to pornography like never before.
- Pornography influences how we see and interact with others.
- We are seeking something holy (set apart) when we go looking for pornography but really what we are seeking can only be found in Jesus Christ.
- Sexting is a form of pornography.



Script

Porn! (pause for effect) Okay, now that I have your attention I want to discuss the impact this one word is having in our world. 24/7 we are exposed to images and messages that only a few years ago would have been considered immoral. However, in today's hyper-sexualized world, they fly across our screens without us giving any thought to what was just seen. I wonder, have we become desensitized to this reality?



Now some of you might be thinking, "Why are we talking about porn? Why is this significant to our lives?" You may be sitting here shocked or confused as to why someone is here to talk to you about porn. What we want you to know is that the reason we need to talk about this is that it impacts our lives and relationships not and in the future far more than we realize. Whether we are the one that struggles with pornography or we know someone that does, it is important we have a dialogue about it.



To start our series I thought we would do something fun. We are going to play a little trivia. Go ahead and get into your small groups and we will start. *(pause to give time to get into small groups)*

Note: After they have broken up into small groups explain that they should have one person who will keep track of answers they got right and wrong. At the end, have the small groups add up their points. If possible have a small reward for the team that wins.
